# COMMUNITY DIRECTOR ROLE DESCRIPTION

## Specific responsibilities

- Working with the Head of Community Boxing to ensure the delivery of the Community Strategy to the timelines outlined in it.
- Chair the Community sub-committee and undertake the roles and responsibilities set out in the Terms of Reference for that Committee. Distribute ToR's for committee members and ensure that minutes of meetings are taken and reported to the Board.
- To keep the Board up to date on progress towards delivery of the Community Strategy and any challenges that might be preventing progress.
- To represent the Board, where requested, in dealing with community matters.
- To contribute specialist advice from the community perspective to the Board's work in strategic planning and leadership.

- A community strategy awareness.
- Knowledge and experience of engaging and empowering children & young people.
- An excellent understanding of community projects.
- Ability to listen effectively.
- Ability to ask probing questions and challenge accordingly.

- Ability to influence and promote the importance of community strategy across an organisation.
- Experience of chairing meetings or sitting on an advisory group (desirable).
